Seen at their best during May, the truly magnificent gardens are an ideal backdrop for our superb sculptures, while large, light rooms in Delamore House provide the perfect setting for paintings and other artworks. The Old Kitchen Café remains a favourite place for our visitors to enjoying light refreshments, with covered seating in the kitchen garden area close by.

Visitors are encouraged to seek out further artworks placed along the tree-lined Millennium Avenue and to visit the impressive cromlech or take a moment to stand quietly amid the many specimen trees, taking in the wonderful flowering shrubs and carefully tended flower beds.


